
1. Can the interior shelves be taken out?

5. Will the door close loudly?

This medicine cabinet has a soft-close stainless steel blum DTC hinge that prevents door slamming.

6. How do I clean and maintain the mirror and cabinet?

- Mirror: Use a soft, lint-free cloth or microfiber towel with a mild glass cleaner. Avoid abrasive cleaners or rough sponges that can scratch the surface.
 - Cabinet Body: Use a soft, damp cloth with a mild soap solution. Wipe dry immediately. Avoid harsh chemicals that could damage the finish.
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7. Can this medicine cabinet be installed recessed into the wall?

8. Can I install a recessed medicine cabinet myself?

If you are an experienced DIYer and confirm there are no wires or pipes in the way, it's possible. However, for a safe and professional finish, especially when relocating electrical wires for an integrated light, we highly recommend hiring a qualified professional.

9. Is it possible to install two units next to each other, and do they need spacing?

Two medicine cabinets can be installed side by side, with a maximum door opening angle of 105 degrees, and that maintaining a certain distance between them is advisable. This will ensure that the cabinet doors can fully open and make them convenient to use.

10.What type of wall is required for installing a surface-mount medicine cabinet?

Surface-mount cabinets require a solid and structurally sound wall. They must be securely anchored into wall studs for drywall installations, or using appropriate concrete anchors for masonry walls like brick or concrete. They are not suitable for installation on thin plaster, hollow tile, or other weak partition walls that cannot support the weight.
