## **Installation Precautions**

- 1. Professional Installation Recommended: The company strongly recommends that installation be performed by a qualified electrician or installer. We shall not be held liable for any product damage, personal injury, or property damage resulting from unprofessional installation.
- 2. Load-Bearing Wall Requirement: This product must be installed on a structurally sound, load-bearing wall capable of supporting its weight. The user is responsible for verifying the wall's structure and load-bearing capacity prior to installation. We are not responsible for damage caused by falling due to an unstable wall.

- 2. Clean Gently: Use a soft, damp cloth to wipe the mirror surface. Do not use abrasive cleaners, scouring pads, or harsh chemicals (e.g., acids, alkalis) that may damage the coating or housing.
- **3.** Ensure Dry Hands: Always dry your hands thoroughly before operating the touch controls, adjusting the power, or handling the plug to prevent electric shock.
- **4.** Disconnect When Not in Use: For extended periods of non-use (e.g., vacations), turn off the power switch or unplug the mirror to save energy and ensure safety.
- **5.** Use Demister Post-Shower: For best results, activate the demisting function after your shower. This is more effective and avoids stressing the electronics in peak humidity.
- **6.** Operate Touch Controls Softly: Press touch sensors gently with your finger. Avoid using excessive force or sharp objects to prevent damage.

- **7.** Avoid Continuous Operation: Turn off functions like lighting or demisting after use. Do not leave them running unnecessarily to conserve energy and prolong the product's lifespan.
- **8.** Professional Installation Required: For hardwired models, installation must be performed by a qualified electrician in compliance with local codes, ensuring proper grounding for safety.
- **9.** Inspect Power Cord Regularly: Check the power cord periodically for any damage. Do not pinch, crush, or bend it severely. Do not attempt to disassemble the mirror yourself.
- **10.**Schedule Safety Checks: Periodically have a qualified electrician verify the power connection's integrity. Stop use immediately and contact customer service if any wire damage is suspected.
